CUTTING TAXES

Reduced property taxes for property owners and reduced income taxes for all Wisconsin taxpayers (2013 Wisconsin Act 20, 2013 Wisconsin Act 145)

MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES
Authored legislation that transformed the delivery and accessibility of mental health services for children and adults across WI (2013 Wisconsin Act 203, 2013 Wisconsin Act 131)

✓ EMPOWERING CITIZENS

Wrote the Milwaukee County Board Reform Law which gave power back to the people to decide if they wanted full or part time county supervisors; more than 70% of voters overwhelmingly passed the referendum to right-size county supervisors pay, saving taxpayers millions (2013 Wisconsin Act 14)

PROTECTING TAXPAYERS AND EDUCATION
Authored legislation to establish an open, transparent
process for selling vacant or under-utilized school buildings
in the city of Milwaukee so parents have an option for
educating their children close to home giving kids the skills
they need to fight their way out of poverty
(2013 Assembly Bill 417)

✓ JOBS

Authored legislation that provided a positive atmosphere for the creation of thousands of family supporting jobs in SE WI

(2013 Wisconsin Act 140)

✓ TOUGH ON CRIME Championed legislation that provided funding to help stop crime from spreading into West Allis and New Berlin. (2013 Wisconsin Act 263)

STOPPED TAX INCREASES

Put forth an amendment to support New Berlin's opposition to a bill that would have stuck New Berlin taxpayer's with a \$240,000 tax hike.

(Assembly Amendment 3 to Assembly Bill 385)

✓ MILWAUKEE COUNTY MENTAL HEALTH BOARD Lead a strong bipartisan effort to reform the delivery of mental health services in Milwaukee County. The bill passed the legislature by an overwhelming 122 – 1 vote, ending a decade long crisis. (2013 Wisconsin Act 203)
